FOREWORD

The First International Working Conference on Stored-Product Entomology was held at Savannah, Georgia, USA, October 7-11, 1974, and the Second Conference was held at Ibadan, Nigeria, September 10-16, 1978. This Third Conference was held October 23-28, 1983, in the K-State Union, Kansas State University, Manhattan, Kansas, USA.

The stated purpose of the Conference was "to provide the opportunity for international scientists to discuss current basic and practical stored-product research and to identify research needs of the future." Five symposia were organized: Basic Biology/Ecology, Chemical Control, Non-Chemical Control, Identification of Pest Problems, and Integrated Pest Management and Extension.

Appreciation is expressed to the KSU Conference Office of Continuing Education for handling mailings, registration, and many of the operational details of the Conference; to the K-State Union for the excellent physical facilities and efficient handling of luncheons and banquet; to the moderators and those who presented papers; to projectionists; and to all the participants, many of whom traveled long distances at much expense to exchange ideas and discuss research.
